


Spelling Bee Bingo™

INSTRUCTIONS

 **WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD -**
Small parts. Not for children under 3 years.



How Do You Win?

Be the first player to fill your bingo card with chips - just like regular bingo.

What's in the Box?

The Spelling Bee board, 26 letter tiles, 12 bingo card (the cards with color borders), 25 spelling bee cards, chips.

Setting Up to Play:

Each player takes one bingo card and places it face up in front of them so all the players can see it.

Separate the tiles carefully by first breaking them into rows and then removing them from each other individually. Discard any blank tiles. Put all 26 letter tiles on the Spelling Bee board face down so that no one can see the letters. Mix them up a bit.

Every player takes 7 yellow chips. Place those off to the side of your card.

Playing - Game #1

The youngest player starts the game by taking any tile from the Spelling Bee board. Turn it over and announce to all the players what letter it is. **ALL THE PLAYERS WHO HAVE THAT LETTER ON THEIR CARD GET TO PLACE A CHIP OVER THAT LETTER WHEREVER IT APPEARS.** The used letter tile is put in the box and is out of play. The player to the left now goes by taking any tile, turning it over and so on.

If, during the game, a player picks a letter that no player has on their card, that letter is also put in the box out of play. No chips are placed on that turn and the next player goes.

Winning:

The first player to cover up all their letters on their card can "Buzz" like a bee to announce that she or he is the winner, or just say "Bingo!"

Game #2 - Advanced

For this version, take the Spelling Bee cards and place them, face down, near all players. Play the game as above except:

If Player A picks a letter that nobody has on their card, the player to their left - Player B - takes the top Spelling Bee card and reads one of the two words on that card. Player A tries to spell that word. If they spell it correctly they place a chip over any open letter on their bingo card. If they do not spell it correctly, their turn ends and the next player goes. That Spelling Bee

card goes to the bottom of the deck and the tile gets put in the box, out of play.

In Case of a Tie:

If more than one player announces "Bingo" at the same time, the game is a tie. You can either both be winners or have a Spelling Bee challenge. The younger player takes the top Spelling Bee card and asks the other player spell a word. If they spell it correctly, they take the next card and ask the younger player to spell a word, each taking turns until one player misspells a word. The other player wins.
