DELUXE CAGE BINGO RULES

For 2 or more players Ages 7 to adult

CONTENTS:

Bingo Cage (automatically selects one number at a time), Tally Card, 100 Bingo Markers, 21 Bingo Cards, 75 Embossed Plastic Number Balls.

OBJECT:

Be the first player to get five numbers in a row, diagonally, horizontally, or vertically and call out "Bingo".

SET UP:

Remove the bingo numbers and bingo markers from their runners; discard the excess runner pieces. To open the bingo cage, turn the cap so that the rib of the cap is in line with the two small dots on the cage, lift it open. Place the number balls in the cage, replace the cap and turn clockwise to lock into place.

PLAYING:

1. Each player takes a turn being the caller. The caller gets the Bingo Cage, the set of 75 Number Balls and the Tally Card. The caller gives one Bingo Card and some of the Markers to each of the players. To start the game, each player covers the center "Free Space" on his or her card. The caller revolves the Bingo Cage by turning the handle a few revolutions forward to mix the balls. As the cage is turned backwards, one of the balls will automatically fall into the Metal Selector Cup and roll forward. The caller removes the ball from the base, calls the number appearing on the ball and then places the ball in the appropriate place on the Tally Card. The caller rotates the Bingo Cage again, obtains a new ball, calls the number and then places the ball in the Tally Card. He continues to do the same until one of the players calls "Bingo".

- When the caller calls a number, the players then look for the number on their cards, and if they have it, they place a round marker on the appropriate place on their card. When a player has five numbers in a row, diagonally, horizontally or vertically, they call out "Bingo".
- 3. The caller then checks the winning card against the Tally Card to make certain that the numbers are correct. If they are correct, the player who called "Bingo" is the winner.
- 4. There are several other varieties of "Bingo" which can be played; filling up the entire board takes the most time to play. Other shorter versions are forming a "T" or "Z" or covering the outer border.
- 5. The caller then places all the balls back in the Bingo Cage, collects the cards, and passes the Cage, Tally Card and Bingo Cards to the player at his right, who then becomes the caller and proceeds as above.
