

# THE SMURFS™

For 2 to 4 players  
Ages 4 and up

## Follow Your Nose Dominoes Rules

### Object:

Be the first player to play all of your dominoes.

### Contents:

28 dominoes

### Set Up:

Place all of the dominoes face down on a table and mix them.

If two people are playing, they each take seven dominoes and put them, face up, in front of them.

If three or four people are playing, they each take five dominoes.

The remaining dominoes form the draw pile.

### Playing:

The youngest player starts by placing any double domino (same Smurf on both ends) that they have in the middle of the table. If they do not have a double, they take a domino from the draw pile. If that domino is a double, the player plays it immediately and ends their turn. If it isn't a double, play moves to the left and the next player plays a double domino or draws and so on. This continues until a double is played.

On every turn a player plays a domino from their hand by interlocking a Smurf's nose into a domino. If a player cannot match a domino with those in play, they take a domino from the draw pile. If it matches any already in play, it can be played immediately. If not, the player keeps it and play passes to the left.

### Ending and winning the game:

The first player to play all their dominoes is the winner. If no more moves can be made and players still have dominoes, the player with the fewest dominoes wins.
