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

BASS ACKWARDS™



Object:

To be the player/team to NOT end up on the START space.

Contents:

240 trivia cards, card holder, 2 sets of choice cards (A,B,C), game board, 2 movers, 2 mover stands

Set Up:

Mix the trivia cards and place them, with the Bass Ackwards logo side face up, near the game board. Place the card holder near the cards.

Put each mover in a mover stand. Divide into teams (it's okay if one team has an extra player). Each team takes a mover and places it at FINISH. Each player takes the set of A,B,C cards that matches its mover.


Playing:

First round

The yellow team goes first. A player from the yellow team takes the top card, keeps it logo side up, and places it in the card holder.

Logo side of card:

The Answer is "Barracuda"



A, B and C are the three different questions. One of these questions is correct for the answer. Teams are trying to find the two INCORRECT questions.

One player from the yellow team reads the answer that's at the top of the card out loud and then reads all three questions that are below it. The card/card holder may be passed around to members of the team.

The team may have a brief discussion and questions may be reread if needed. The team then decides on one question—either A, B or C—that they believe is one of the two WRONG answers. They place the corresponding choice card—A, B or C—face up in front of them.

Example: If the team decides that question A is one of the wrong answers, they place the A card, face up, in front of them.

After the yellow team has played their A, B or C card, the blue team has a brief discussion and selects one of the remaining two questions that they think is also wrong. (They cannot choose the same letter that the first team selected.) They put the corresponding A, B or C card face up in front of them.

When both teams have selected their choose cards, the reader flips the card over and reads the two incorrect questions for the answer and they can read the correct question, too.

Scoring:

Any team that has selected an INCORRECT question gets to stay where they are on the game board.

If the first team to choose A, B, or C (in this first round, the yellow team) selected the CORRECT question, they move one space towards START.

If the second team to choose A, B or C (in this first round, the blue team) selected the CORRECT question, they move TWO spaces towards start.

Next Round:

Teams switch order of reading for each round so, in round 2, the blue team will select a question first and so on.
