BUMPER TOPS RULES

Object:

Knock your opponent's Pokémon down to score a point. Score 10 points to win the match.




Contents:

Bumper Tops arena, 4 tops, 2 scorings pegs, label sheet

Set Up:

Place the arena on a flat surface. Carefully remove the Pokémon from the label sheet and place one on the flat side of each of the four tops.



Using the package as a guide, place the other labels on the areas shown.

Each player takes the two tops that matches his/her launcher. Place one of your tops into the slot next to the launcher. Turn the top so the ridges on the bottom fit into the ridges on the launcher. Each player takes a matching color scoring peg and places it in the first hole of their track, to the right.

Playing:

At the count of 1-2-3, players give their launchers a quick turn to the right (in the direction of the arrow on the launcher). The top will spin out of the slot and into the arena.


Ending and winning the game:

The Pokémon will whirl around the arena and slam into each other until one or both of them are knocked down. When a top is

knocked down, the top that is left standing gets a point and moves their scoring peg up one space. In case of a tie, the round is re-played. The first player to reach the last space of their scoring track wins.

Using 4 Pokémon

Play and scoring is the same as above except after you launch your first Pokémon, immediately launch your second one so that there are 4 Pokémon in the arena at the same time. To win a round, a player must knock down BOTH of their opponent's Pokémon. The winner of the round must have at least one of his Pokémon left standing.
